Mission:

SouthWest Mobile County Chamber believes in encouraging & cultivating young people in our area to make a positive difference in their community. Through this program, we will offer experiences to empower selected participants to emerge as leaders and trustees of our community.

About:

TALL is a community leadership development program of the Southwest Mobile County Chamber of Commerce. It is an 8 Month program beginning in September and ending in April with a graduation ceremony. The program is designed to inform, motivate and increase the awareness of each participant through interaction with community leaders, training seminars, field trips, and volunteering for various community events. TALL Program participants receive first-hand knowledge of local economic, political and social issues impacting the community. They will garner leadership skills by building relationships with peers and community leaders, broaden their awareness of community needs, and learn what it takes to become a consensus builder and effective decision-maker. Our goal is to celebrate student achievement and to instill a genuine concern for and commitment to help shape our community. After graduating from the program, these students are prepared to put their talents to work and take on future leadership opportunities. TALL students are chosen through an application process and selection is based upon academic performance, school activities and community involvement. This program is a gateway to our scholarship process and all students must enroll and complete the T.A.L.L. Program to be eligible for scholarships.

Eligibility & Program Requirements:

TALL is an exclusive program offered to hard-working, exemplary high school students with a desire to expand their horizons and their exposure to businesses and organizations around Southwest Mobile County. Students must attend school in Mobile County. All applicants will be reviewed by a panel of community leaders, and finalists will be invited for an interview. Selection is based on potential or demonstrated leadership abilities, academic excellence, and commitment to school and community. Selections will be made in June and all applicants will be notified of the results by July.

- Applicants will not be considered unless ALL information is submitted by **April 30**th, **2025.** Information must be submitted together in one packet (application, three references, transcript, and photo). **The Chamber will not accept partial packets.** Packets may be turned in to the Chamber Office or mailed to 5055 Carol Plantation Rd, Mobile, AL 36619. **No applications, recommendations, or other requirements will be accepted through email.**

Expectations:

- Commit to participate fully and meet attendance requirements for monthly sessions
- Complete necessary service time and assignments outside of monthly sessions
- Represent the Southwest Mobile County Chamber of Commerce in a professional and exemplary manner Participants must make a **commitment** to the program. Attendance at each monthly session are prerequisites for graduation certification and consideration for scholarship. Students who fail to adhere to the above requirements may be dismissed from the program. The leadership steering committee will review each situation and make a decision regarding continued participation in the program.

All selected members of the program will be required to pay a \$25.00 registration fee to cover their supplies.
