Josh Hall of CRE Mobile, representing the property owner in the transaction, reported last month that McCarron Development leased the 16th-floor penthouse office space in the Waterman-Smith Building located at 61 St. Joseph Street in Downtown Mobile. Jay D. Roberds II of CRE Mobile worked for the tenant.

A.J. McCarron, the former University of Alabama quarterback hailing from Mobile, will occupy the 4,200-square-foot space alongside other investors on his team. McCarron has several developments reportedly in the works around Mobile and Baldwin counties, including the new Topgolf facility set to open later this year at McGowin Park in West Mobile.

The Pillars Mobile found at 1757 Government Street recently reopened after a major remodel and has already played host to a public event, according to a recent news release. The co-owners are siblings **Shelley Gay** and **Bryant Knight**, who moved back to Mobile and bought the building last summer, when the duo immediately began a major remodeling project for weddings and other related events.

The aim was to create a visually entertaining event space by blending colorful wallpaper with mixed decor. Built in 1910, The Pillars Mobile has remained a landmark for locals and visitors over the years under various local ownership. The 8,000-square-foot footprint has eight fireplaces, historic Bellingrath tiles and a 150-year-old-stained glass window in the atrium.

Lush Florist & Gifts has moved from 1910 Government Street to a new site located at 757 Government Street and held a ribbon-cutting event this month to celebrate. The popular floral design and gift shop is owned by Susan George and offers home and garden décor with a full-service florist. The new space will be open Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Additionally, Lush recently leased a location in the Southwood Place shopping center found at **6808 Airport Blvd**. in West Mobile.

Dough Boy Pizza, the latest restaurant concept spun off by **Erica Barrett**, owner of SOCU Southern Kitchen and Oyster Bar, has leased 1,406-square-feet of restaurant space inside the historic Blue Bird Hardware building found at 2724 Old Shell Road, according to **Jay O'Brien** of **Stirling Properties**, who represented both sides of the transaction.

The 12-unit **55 East Drive Apartments** in West Mobile was sold in May for **\$1.35 million** to a local investor, according to **Cameron Weavil** with **The Weavil Company**, who represented the buyer in the transaction. **Kenny Nichols of Vallas Realty** represented the sellers in the deal.

Jill Meeks of Stirling Properties reported that Children's Aid Society of Alabama has leased some 1,528-square-feet of space found at 5901 Airport Blvd. in West Mobile last month.


