**Jo Bonner** is the fourth president of the University of South Alabama.

Previously, Bonner served as chief of staff to Alabama Governor Kay Ivey. He joined the Ivey Administration in December 2018, as Senior Advisor to the Governor. Before joining the Governor's Office, he served as Vice Chancellor for Economic Development at The University of Alabama System (UAS) from 2013 to 2018. During his final year at UAS, he was an executive on loan, serving as Interim Executive Director of the Tuscaloosa County Industrial Development Authority.

For more than a decade, he represented Alabama's First District in the U.S. House of Representatives. He was first elected to the 108th Congress in November 2002 and was reelected to five additional terms. As a student at The University of Alabama, he worked on Capitol Hill as an intern for Congressman Jack Edwards. After graduation, he returned to Washington as press secretary and later chief of staff to Congressman Sonny Callahan.

In Congress, he earned a reputation as a respected and influential voice of reason in both Alabama and Washington. He was a member of the House Appropriations Committee, where he served on three key subcommittees, and chaired the House Ethics Committee. Widely respected on both sides of the aisle, he was selected by House Speaker John Boehner to serve as chairman of Ethics during the 112th Congress. His crowning Congressional accomplishment came in 2012 when Airbus announced plans to build its first U.S. Final Assembly Line in Mobile. Over the years, Congressman Bonner developed friendships and strategic partnerships with the top corporate leaders at Airbus, one of the world's largest aerospace and defense companies. Airbus has invested more than \$1 billion in Alabama, creating thousands of new jobs in the aerospace industry. This puts Mobile on track to become the fourth largest commercial aviation city in the world

President Bonner has received numerous awards and honors, including a 2021 induction into the Alabama Academy of Honor; the Academy is the state's premiere recognition of 100 living Alabamians for their outstanding accomplishments and service. In 2016, the Business Council of Alabama (BCA) created the inaugural Congressman Jo Bonner Spirit of Leadership Award and honored Bonner as its first recipient. In 2013, he received the Distinguished Public Service Award, the highest honor the U.S. Navy bestows on a civilian. He also received the 2012 Governor Bob Riley Building a Better Alabama Award by the BCA.

Bonner earned a B.A. degree in Journalism from The University of Alabama in 1982. He is married to the former Janée Lambert, of Mobile, and they are the parents of a daughter, Lee, and a son, Robins.



# REAL ESTATE CORNER

Theodore-headquartered **Core Industries** entered into an agreement in July with **CM Biomass**, one of the largest independent wood pellet trading companies in the world, to construct a modern processing and storage facility. As part of the terms, Core will receive, store and load wood pellets for shipment. To accommodate this collaboration, Core will invest \$8.75 million in the construction of two new warehouses, each with a footprint of **57,600 square feet**, at its current locale found at 2460 Claudia Lane in the Theodore Industrial Park. The project is expected to create **28 new jobs** over the next five years. Copenhagen, Denmark-based CM Biomass also has a production facility in Jackson, Alabama, and Habitat for Humanity of Southwest recently bought a pellet mill in Washington County. The new processing site at Core's existing space in Theodore will allow CM Biomass to enhance its distribution and logistics capabilities for these operations.

**Stirling Properties** recently announced the following real estate transactions:

**Premier Transport**, a provider of nonemergency medical transportation for the elderly and disabled, has leased an 1,800-squarefoot space at 1708 Dauphin Street in Mobile. Amanda Goldman represented the tenant and Jay Roberds, II of CRE Mobile, worked for the landlord in the deal.

A local investor bought a 2,400-square-foot building found at 3954 Demetropolis Road in West Mobile, according to Jay O'Brien. The new owner will have 1,150 square feet of flexible space with a roll-up door available for lease.

**Trintalya's Boutique & Gifts** has leased a 1,300-square-foot suite within the shopping center at Cottage Plaza found at 8306 Cottage Hill Road in West Mobile, **Jill Meeks** managed the transaction.

**Knots Salon** is moving to Airport Oaks at 7449 Airport Boulevard in West Mobile. **Angela McArthur** represented the landlord and helped the tenant in this transaction.

Vallas Realty, working closely with listing agent Manning Courtney at Courtney & Morris **Real Estate Inc.**, reported that an out-oftown buyer was found in July to buy the long empty 33,625-square-foot former Moorer YMCA building found at 101 North Water Street in Downtown Mobile. The new owner will begin the process of converting the building, with construction expected to begin soon.

10 acres of land located at 1341 West I-65 Service Rd North, within **Mobile County's** "Opportunity Zone", with easy access to both North and South I-65 was sold for \$340,000 last month by local owner, **Reverend Thomas J Rodi**. The buyers, **CRIMSIMF Inc.**, **An Illinois Corporation**, plan on developing the property sometime this year. Pratt Thomas with Merrill P Thomas Co., Inc represented both the buyer and seller in this transaction.

**Alabama** held a dedication ceremony last month for homes it calls "the side-by-sides" at **7245** and **7249 Third Street** in West Mobile. Completion of the properties has been a long time coming, as staff have dealt with supply and labor shortages over the past three years. The houses are the **226th** and **227th** new homes constructed by the local nonprofit, which will celebrate its 35th anniversary in September.

**Chris Harle of White-Spunner Realty** recently represented the landlord in the lease of a 2,410 square foot property for **Mojeaux's**, a new restaurant founded by local chef **Chris Banks**. The site is situated at 396 Azalea Road in West Mobile.

The 1,900 square foot **Christian Warehouse** Store found at 1128 Hillcrest Road in West Mobile opened for business last month, according to husband-and-wife co-owners **Doug** and **Bette** Meduna.


