

REAL ESTATE CORNER

With its standard one-month lag in collection and reporting of data, last month the **Gulf Coast** Multiple Listing Service (MLS) highlighted key indicators that tracked current trends and dynamics within the **Mobile County** real estate market for **July.** An increase of **3.88%** in demand was seen in July when compared to June, even in the face of rising interest rates. The service said this statistic speaks to the equilibrium between supply and demand in Mobile County real estate, which offers a range of options for those looking to make property investments. The median sold price for properties in Mobile County stood at \$225,000 in July, experiencing a slight decline of **2.17%** in comparison to June. The service said this adjustment highlights the market's adaptability in the face of changing conditions, while supporting overall stability. July saw an extension in the median days on the market to 16 days, marking a 33.3% increase from the previous month.

"This shift provides potential buyers with an extended timeframe to explore available properties, fostering more considered decisions," the report said. Sellers are recommended to expect a slightly longer selling process. The **list-to-sold** price percentage edged up to **98**% in July, reflecting a slight improvement of **0.21**% from June. "This statistic signifies that properties are being accurately priced, resulting in prices that are closely aligned with the final negotiated sale prices. Both buyers and sellers can benefit from this increased pricing accuracy," MLS added. The number of properties listed in Mobile County experienced steady growth in July, with a **2.8**% increase, totaling **872** properties.

The Mobile County Commission has approved a contract to begin construction for the Dauphin Island Causeway Restoration Project, which will restore tidal habitat along the 3.3-mile stretch of Dauphin Island Causeway from Mobile County's Bayfront Park to Cedar Point. The project is funded by grants from the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation Emergency Coastal Resilience Fund and the Gulf Environmental Benefit Fund with the goals of protecting infrastructure and creating habitat injured by the Deepwater Horizon oil spill, respectively.

No matching funds will be needed from the commission. **Carter Contracting Services**, **Inc**. was awarded the job of constructing

the rock breakwaters for \$26,685,698. The edifice will be placed roughly parallel to the causeway at variable offshore distances, to recreate known historic shoreline proportions. It is to protect both the causeway and nearly 300 acres of healthy, productive salt marsh habitat to the west of the causeway. Work is expected to begin this fall and conclude by summer 2024.

Habitat for Humanity of Southwest Alabama, responsible for building and renovating more than 325 homes throughout Mobile, Clarke and Washington counties, helping underprivileged home ownership to improve communities through sustainable partnerships, is hosting its 35th anniversary event at Greer's St. Louis Market on 260 St. Louis Street. The event will be held on September 21 from 6 to 9 p.m. Tickets are \$35, and sponsorships are still available. Contact Interfaith Coordinator Sue King for more information.


