White-Spunner Realty recently announced the opening last month of three businesses in the Piccadilly Square Shopping Center found at 6345 Airport Boulevard in West Mobile. Taco Mama leased 3,140-square-feet of eatery space and is open for business. Chris Harle of White-Spunner Realty represented the landlords, and Kenny Nichols of Vallas Realty worked for the tenant in the transaction. Blue Magnolia Boutique, an online store offering women's clothing, leased a 1,200-square-foot area, its first brick-and -mortar site, and is now open. Harle and Leigh Dale Younce of White-Spunner Realty represented the landlords in the deal. Bapu's Food Stop leased 1,200-square-feet of restaurant space is open for lunch and dinner. Bapu's originates from Pensacola and specializes in halal Syrian food. Younce and Harle worked for the landlords in the deal.

After being closed for more than 15 years, the Linksman Golf Course in West Mobile near Dog River is soon reopening. Last month, Mobile County Commission awarded a \$13.7-million contract to Mid-America Golf & Landscape to start construction. This funding, along with American Rescue Plan Act funds, will be used to upgrade fairways, tee boxes and greens. The revamped course will feature a designated practice area specifically for Mobile County students. Construction is set to begin this month, with plans to open the driving range and practice facility by September. The new par-70 course is expected to open in summer or early fall 2025.

Mobile-based fine dining restaurant Dumbwaiter announced last month that it is now offering franchising opportunities. The restaurant will offer a training program, providing the skills and knowledge needed to run a Dumbwaiter Restaurant, along with support at each step. This includes site selection, marketing support and ongoing training. Rumored targeted sites currently include West Mobile and Baldwin County. "This is a great time to join the Southern culinary landscape," a media announcement said.

A new eatery, The Breakfast Spot, opened last month in Mobile at 119 Dauphin Street next to Subway. The 1,500-square-foot space was previously home to FOY Superfoods before shuttering in 2022. The Breakfast Spot is offering Mardi Gras-themed dishes and is also currently hiring. More information can be found on their website.

Last month Brandon Broadus of CRE Mobile reported that the owners of Elev8te Sports Bar & Grill paid \$580,000 for a 5,276-square -foot restaurant building found at 2617 Dauphin Street in Mobile. Broadus represented the buyer, while Andrew Chason and Stephen Sewell of Marcus & Millichap worked for the seller.
